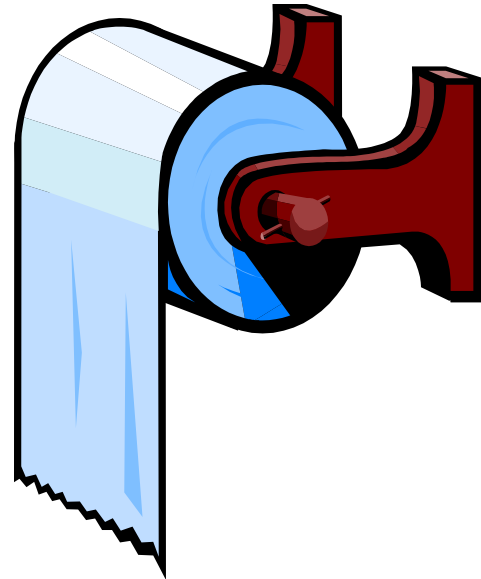


# What Not To Flush
